DUNEDIN GOAL
STREET.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Governor to stop up a Portion of a certain Public Street in the City of Dunedin, and to dispose of the Lands over which such Portion of such Public Street passed.

[20th November, 1877.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS in consequence of a permanent streetmay having been laid out over other lands, a portion of the public street in the City of Dunedin known as Goal Street is not required to be maintained at its present width as a public street or thoroughfare, and it is expedient that such portion of the said public street should be stopped up and should cease to be a public street and thoroughfare; and it is also expedient that the Governor should be empowered to sell, exchange, or otherwise dispose of the lands over which such portion of the said public street passed :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

Dunedin Gaol Street.

LOCAL.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Dunedin Gaol Street **Short Title.**
Act, 1877."

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor, and he is hereby authorized **Governor authorized**
and empowered, to stop up all or any of such portion of the public **to stop up certain**
street as is particularly described with regard to its situation, course, **portion of public**
boundaries, and admeasurements in the Schedule to this Act annexed. **street.**

3. Before the said portion of the said public street is stopped up **Sixty days' notice**
by the Governor, he shall cause a notice to be inserted in at least two **to be given**
newspapers published in Dunedin, describing in general terms the
situation, length, and course of the said portion of the said public
street intended to be stopped up, and calling upon all persons object-
ing to the stopping up of such portion of such public street to
state in writing any well-grounded objections they may have to the
stopping up of such portion of such public street, and to leave
within sixty days from the first publication of such notice such state-
ment addressed to the Commissioner of Crown Lands, at his office in
Dunedin, add marked "Objections to closing Gaol Street ;" and on or
before the day of publication of the said notice, maps exhibiting the
portion of the street intended to be stopped up shall be deposited at
the Land Office in the said City of Dunedin, and there shall be printed,
written, or lithographed on the said maps a notice intimating the last
day for lodging such objections : Provided that if the delineation of
the said portion of the said public street intended to be stopped up is
not contained in a map of a single sheet, but is contained in a map of
more sheets than one, it shall be sufficient to deposit at such office the
sheet or sheets of such map on which is delineated the said portion of
the said public street intended to be stopped up, or copies thereof
respectively.

4. At the expiration of the sixty days' notice, if no objections have **After notice,**
been made, or if the Governor, upon consideration of the objections **Governor to**

fare, and shall no longer form part of the streets of the City of
Dunedin, and the Governor may thereupon take such proceedings as
he may think fit for stopping up such portion of the said public street.

5. It shall be lawful for the Governor, and he is hereby authorized **Governor may**

6. It shall be lawful for the Governor to exchange any of the **Governor may**
said lands over which the said portion of the said public street stopped **exchange land.**
up under the provisions of this Act passed for any other lands, and to
complete and perform any contracts heretofore entered into for the
exchange of such lands for other lands over which a new public street
has been made, in lieu of the said portion of the said public street
stopped up under the provisions of this Act, so soon as the lands over
which such new public street has been made shall have been conveyed
to Her Majesty in exchange for any lands over which the stopped up
portion of the said public street passed, and the lands so conveyed in
exchange to Her Majesty shall be vested in Her Majesty, her heirs
and successors for ever, subject to the rights of the public to use the
surface thereof as public street or highway.

7. At all times after the passing of this Act, maps of the said **Map of portion of**

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Provincial District of Otago, in the Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement one (1) rood and twenty (20) perches, more or less, situate in the City of Dunedin, and marked Goal Street on the map of the said city, being the western half of the said street. Bounded towards the West-north-west by Block numbered XV. and Crown lands, seven hundred and seventy-seven (777) links; towards the North-north-east by Stuart Street, fifty (50) links; towards the East-south-east by other portion of Goal Street, seven hundred and twenty-seven (727) links; and towards the South-southeast by High Street, seventy and seven-tenth (70.7) links.

AN ACT to authorize the Governor to grant or otherwise assure to the body corporate of the County of Vincent certain Land in the Township of Clyde, and portion of Longstone Street, in the said Town.

[20th November, 1877]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the piece of land described in the First Schedule hereto was granted under "The Public Reserves Act, 1854," and "The Public Reserves Act, 1862," to the Superintendent of the late Province of Otago and his successors, upon trust for municipal purposes: And whereas the piece of land described in the Second Schedule hereto forms portion of Longstone Street, in the said town: And whereas it is expedient to authorize the Governor to grant or otherwise assure to the body corporate of the County of Vincent the said two pieces of land:

BE IT THEREFORE EXACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Clyde Public Reserves Grant Act, 1877."

2. Immediately on this Act coming into operation the peice of land described in the Second Schedule hereto shall cease to be portion of Longstone Street and a public road.

3. The Governor may grant or otherwise assure to the body corporate of the County of Vincent the pieces of land described in the First and Second Schedules hereto.

4. Upon the issue of any such grant, or the execution of any such assurance, the land granted or assured shall vest in the body corporate of the said county, in fee-simple, discharged from all uses and trusts theretofore affecting the same.

On Act coming into operation, land in Second Schedule to cease to be a public road.
Governor may grant, &c., to body corporate of Vincent, land in First and Second Schedules.

Upon issue of grant, land to vest in body corporate in fee-simple, discharged from all uses and trusts.

AN **ACT** to authorize the Wanganui Gas Company (Limited) to break up Streets and Bridges, and to lay down and place Pipes, Conduits, and Service-pipes, and to make and construct other Works for supplying the Borough of Wanganui and Suburbs with Gas.

WHEREAS a joint stock company has been incorporated under the provisions of "The Joint Stock Companies Act, 1860," and the Joint Stock Companies Act Amendment Acts, by the name of "The Wanganui Gas Company (Limited)," having for its object the production and supply of gas in and for the Town and Borough of Wanganui and its vicinity, and the sale of coal and coke, and the doing all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects: And whereas it is expedient that provision should be made authorizing the said Company to break up streets and bridges in and through the Borough of Wanganui and the suburbs thereof, and to lay down and place pipes, conduits, service-pipes, and to make and construct other works for supplying the said Borough of Wanganui and suburbs with gas, and for other purposes relating thereto, and to the objects for which the said Company has been established :
